

About Dr. Cetiner...

Mustafa Cetiner was born in Kayseri in 1964.

He received his MD degree at Ankara University School of Medicine in 1988. He pursued his career at the Department of Hematology in Marmara University Faculty of Medicine as a fellow, an attending physician and an associated professor respectively.

He participated in research projects of the Hematopoietic Stem Cell Transplant Program in Northwestern University Robert Lurie Cancer Center, Chicago, US as a visiting scholar between 2004 and 2005.

He established Bone Marrow Transplantation Program in Sisli Memorial Hospital and became a director in 2011-2012.

Dr. Cetiner was a professor of the Hematology Department at Koc University School of Medicine between years of 2013 and 2018. He served as a founder and head of the Internal Medicine Department at Koc University School of Medicine in 2015-2018.

He worked at the Hematology Department of V.K.V. American Hospital from 2008 to 2019.

He has been working as an official doctor of "United Nations" since 2010.

He served as a general secretary of the "Multiple Myeloma" and "Acute Leukemia" Boards of the Turkish Society of Hematology.

He was appointed as a chief of Bone Marrow Failure Subcommittee of the Turkish Society of Hematology between 2014-2018.

He organized "Istanbul Lymphoma Society" conferences and worked as a general secretary of the society until 2015.

He has been a co-chairman of the recognized international meeting "New Trends in Hematology" organized in Istanbul since 2007 - 2019.

Besides his academic career, Dr. Cetiner remarkably contributes to social responsibility projects. He is among the founders of "Cancer Survivor Foundation" in Turkey that is dedicated to providing care and support for cancer patients and their families. He currently continues his workings as a vice president and board member of the foundation.

Further, he had an active role on establishment of "Multiple Myeloma Support Society" and still serves as an honorary advisor of the society.

He has received several awards for his remarkable efforts to education and contributions to hematology during his career. He has attended to several renowned scientific national and international meetings as an organizer, speaker, jury member, moderator and participant. He has given more than 100 speeches and presented abstracts in various national and international conferences.

Dr. Cetiner is interested with innovative approaches for medical education, medical ethics and history of medicine besides his main field of hematology.

He has an extensive and prominent career as an author. He has published over 50 articles in peer-reviewed scientific national and international journals also 3 books about hematological malignancies.

In addition, he has also 3 popular science books titled “To Your Health”, “Portraits from the History of Lymphoma” and “The Milestones in the History of Hematology”.

He was a co-founder of magazine “Health for Everyone” and served as an advisory board coordinator of the magazine.

He published over 500 columns under the title of “Actual Medicine” in national “Cumhuriyet (Republic) Newspaper” for 10 years till 2017.

Currently, he continues to write his columns in weekly “Science and Technology Magazine”.

He has been an editor of the “Bulletin of Turkish Hematology Association” and national journal called “Masters of Medicine” since 2018.

He was a regular guest of TV show “Cancer and Life” broadcasted in national “CNN Turk” channel and served as a scientific advisor of the show between 2007-2008.
